Certificate of identity by gazetted officer for aadhar card

In case of non-availability of documents, an individual is required to provide the proof in a certificate form issued by the specified functionaries. In a bid to make applying for Aadhaar card easier for individuals not having the required documents, the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) has issued a circular to standardise the format in which the applicant can give information from functionaries such as MP, MLA and so on. The UIDAI, in a circular dated November 27, states, "In view of the problems being faced by the residents due to non-availability of the standard format for getting the certificates from various functionaries such as MP or MLA or Gazetted officer or Tehsildar or Head of Educational Institution or Councillor or Head of Orphanage or Head of Village Panchayat, it has been decided to introduce Standard certificate namely Certificate for Aadhaar Enrolment/Update in schedule II of Regulation 10(2) for Aadhaar enrolment and Update (Annexure I & II enclosed). The validity of this certificate is only three months from the date of issue. " An individual can apply for Aadhaar card via three ways - Document based, Head of Family based or Introducer based. Also Read: Documents required to apply for Aadhaar card Document based method allows an individual to apply for Aadhaar card if he has valid proof of identity, proof of address and date of birth proof. However, in case an individual does not have the required documents, then there are two ways to apply for Aadhaar card, i.e., either via Head of Family based method or Introducer based method. Also Read: How to apply for Aadhaar card without documents In case of non-availability of documents, an individual is required to provide the proof of identity, proof of address and/or date of birth date in a certificate issued by the specified functionaries. Aadhaar is a 12-digit unique identification number issued by the UIDAI on behalf of the government to every resident of India. It is a biometric document, which records your personal information in the government database. Aadhaar acts as a single identification document, and does not replace PAN, Passport, Driving license or any other identification documents. It is issued to the residents of India based on their biometric and demographic data. Under the Aadhaar Act, 2016, every resident can apply for an Aadhaar number. A resident is a person who has been living in the country for 182 days or more in the year immediately preceding the date of application for enrolment. If you meet this condition and wish to enrol for Aadhaar, you will have to submit certain documents that support your claims. The documents to be submitted at the UIDAI authorized centres are not too many and the whole process is quite simple. The kind of documents you have to hand over can be divided into four sections - Proof of Identity, Proof of Address, Proof of Date of Birth and Proof of Relationship. Documents supporting proof of identity help confirm that you are who you claim to be. All the documents used to serve as identity proof will contain your name and photo at the least. Carry any of the following documents with you as proof of identity when you visit any Aadhaar enrolment centre to register for Aadhaar: Passport Ration card NREGS job card Government photo ID cards PAN card Photo bank ATM card ECHS/CGHS photo card Driving license Voter ID Arms license Photo ID is issued by an authorized educational institution Photo credit card Certificate of identity with photo issued by gazetted officer or Tehsildar on a letterhead Kissan photo passbook Pensioner photo card Freedom fighter photo card Disability ID card or handicapped medical certificate Address card containing name and picture issued by the Department of Posts Documents supporting proof of address help confirm that your address is where you claim to live. All the documents used to serve as address proof will contain your name and address at the least. Make sure to mention the correct address in your application form since your Aadhaar card will be sent to the address you have mentioned. You can submit any of the following documents as proof of date of birth when you visit any Aadhaar enrolment centre to register for Aadhaar: Passport SSC certificate Birth certificate PAN card Certificate of date of birth and issued by group a gazetted officer on a letterhead State/central pension payment order Mark sheet issued by government university or board The documents that support your proof of relationship should mention details about your relationship with the head of the family. The documents required when you apply for an Aadhaar card can be divided into four sections - Proof of Identity - Passport, Ration card, PAN card, Driving license, Voter ID, etc. Proof of Address - Ration card, Voter ID, Driving license, Passport, bank statement/passbook, etc. Proof of Date of Birth - Passport, SSLC certificate, Birth certificate, PAN card, etc. Proof of Relationship - PDS Card, job card of MNRGA, Passport, marriage certificate, etc. Can Aadhaar card be used as address proof? Yes, Aadhaar card can serve as address proof across the country. What documents will be accepted as proof of address and proof of identity? Your mobile number can be (re)linked to Aadhaar either by visiting the nearest outlet of your service provider or by dialling the toll-free number (which will be listed by your service operator) from your mobile number registered with Aadhaar. In both cases, you will receive an OTP to complete the verification process. How to apply for Aadhar card for kids? Aadhaar card can be availed for children, even new-born babies. To apply for one, the parent or guardian should take the child to the nearest Aadhaar centre. The Aadhaar number of the parent or guardian will have to be submitted along with the child's Birth certificate. Biometric will not be collected until the child reaches five years of age. The child's Aadhaar will be linked to the parent's Aadhaar. What are the documents required for NRIs? The procedure to avail an Aadhaar card is the same for Indian Residents and Non-Resident Indians. To apply for an Aadhaar card, the Non-Resident Indian can go to the UIDAI website and look for an UIDAI authorized enrolment centre that is close to his or her residence. After selecting the enrolment centre, the NRI can directly go to the authorized Aadhaar enrolment centre, carrying the proof of identity and other necessary documents. Once all the documents are submitted, the individual will be requested to provide the biometric information. Non-Resident Indians who wish to apply for Aadhaar are required to carry certain basic documents when they visit the enrolment centre. The following documents are accepted by the UIDAI for this purpose: Proof of identity - PAN card or Ration card or Passport or Voter ID or Driving license or government/PSU photo id, etc. Proof of address - Voter ID or Passport or Ration card or Driving license or government/PSU photo ID or gas connection bill or electricity bill or water bill or landline bill or bank passbook or credit card statement, etc. Proof of date of birth - Birth certificate or Passport or PAN card or government/PSU photo ID, etc. Certificate of identity having photo issued by gazetted officer format for aadhar card. certificate of identity issued by gazetted officer for aadhar card. certificate of identity having photo issued by gazetted officer for aadhar card. who is gazetted officer for aadhar card. how to get certificate of identity from gazetted officer
